To Aid others by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak, and my substance to the needy.

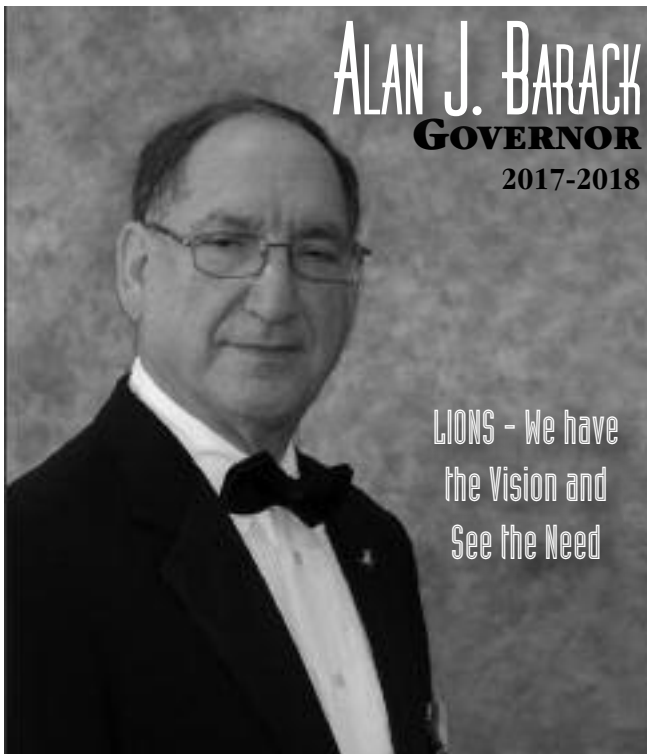
To Be Careful with my criticism and liberal with my praise; to build up and not destroy.

AWARDS

MILT TUTTLE

Named after PID Milton H. Tuttle A long-time member of the Des Plaines Lions Club, which was chartered in 1924, Lion Milton H. Tuttle quickly became a stalwart Lion. He served in the chairs of his club and as District Governor District 1-F in 1961-62. Of the many stories he related, one that was special to everyone, was his description of his relationship with Melvin Jones, the founder of Lionism. Over the years, Lion Milt served the District Cabinet in an advisory capacity after his year as Governor. In 1975, PDG Tuttle was elected by the Lions during an International Convention, and he served as International Director in 1976-78. **Awarded to a Lion who exemplifies servant leadership and is selected by the District Governor.**

JOHN GREENER

Named after PDG John L. Greener Lion John Greener was loyal, dedicated and promotive of Lions and the causes we support. In the almost 30 years that he had been active in Lions, he gave of his time and efforts in many areas that have positively impacted Lionism in Illinois. He promoted Lionism in his club, Morton Grove Lions, in all the club offices; as a District officer, Lion John worked his to 1-F Governor in 1990-91. His service includes past District Lioness Chairman, SightFirst Chairman, and L.E.H.P. Chairman. During his term as Lions of Illinois Foundation Trustee, he served as it's President for a one year term.

Service awards Lion John received included a Membership Key, an LIF Ambassador of Good Will, and two International President's Leadership Awards. Lion John was honored with a Melvin Jones Fellow and was a Lions of Illinois Foundation Fellow. His list of accomplishments and efforts to further the cause of Lionism is only topped by the humble way he served those in need. **This award is presented to the Lion in District 1-F who exemplifies these qualities and Lionistic service. Nomination is by any Lion.**

LIONS CLUB OF THE YEAR

In memory of PDG A.G. "Ang" Marcheschi Lion Marcheschi joined the Lions Club of Niles in 1956 and quickly began making a positive and indelible mark into Lionism. Lion Ang served as a Director and as Secretary before becoming President in 1960. In 1960, he filled in a partial term as Zone Chair, and went on to hold his first whole term as Zone Chair in 1961 and moved up through the position of Deputy Governor, until he was elected District Governor in 1966-67, for which he received the 100% District Governor Award.

Lion Ang served with a passion to help the blind, and in 1970 he chaired the Lions of Illinois Blind Activities Committee. Together with PID Norm Dahl, he spearheaded the creation of the Lions of Illinois Foundation in 1974, and discharged his duties in such an outstanding manner he was named its first president. Several years later, he was named President Emeritus in recognition of his outstanding service. Lion Ang received numerous International Presidents Awards and held a Senior Master Membership Key. He also received the highly prestigious award of Ambassador of Goodwill. Lion Ang was named a Life Member of Lions Clubs International and a Life Director of the Lions Club of Niles.

After his death in 1990, room L101 in the Lions of Illinois Eye Research Institute was dedicated to his memory. PDG Ang was 69 at the time of his death and was married. He had one son who preceded him in death.

Awarded by the Governor to the club(s) that deserves special recognition for exemplary service to the community, significant growth and/or operational improvement or has successfully presented an individual project. Selected by Governor. May be awarded to more than one club, that exemplifies significant growth, projects or other activities.



RICHARD KERSCHER LION OF THE YEAR

Named after PDG Richard F Kerscher PDG Kerscher joined the Northbrook Lions in 1974 and served that club on many committees, as well as Director, and Secretary, for which he received the District 100% Secretary's Award, Tail Twister, Vice President and President for three terms, receiving the 100% President's Award for two terms.

Lion Rich also held two Membership Keys from International. He was appointed to the District Cabinet as Zone Chair in 1980, after three years, he served as Deputy Governor for four before being elected as Lieutenant Governor in 1987.

Lion Rich was elected in grand fashion as Governor at the 1988 District Convention. His courage and dedication was an inspiration to the entire District. Overcoming numerous health problems, Lion Rich served as an outstanding Governor for most of the 1988-89 year, until his death at the age of 43, shortly before the end of his term. He was single and lived in Glenview since 1975. The award-winning Lion best exemplifies Lionistic service. **Nomination is by Club President.**

ROBERT ABBOTT

Named after Lion Robert E. Abbott Robert Abbott held the office of Waukegan Little Fort Lions Secretary for 35 years. In the majority of those 35 years, he was the recipient of the 100% Secretary's Award, which is presented by the Immediate Past Governor. Eugene was his middle name, but it should have been "Service" as he worked diligently in the education field, particularly with special needs children for most of his life. He won many awards and commendations over the years, and exemplified our Lions motto "We Serve." District 1-F Lions lost Lion Bob on June 13, 2010. He will be missed, but his legacy lives on in this Award.

Presented to the officer who best exemplifies attention to detail and excellence in performance of their duties, and is nominated by a Zone Chairperson.

100% SECRETARY

1. Maintain club in good standing. As of May 30, 2018, the club should not have a balance greater than \$50 to Lions Clubs International. All dues (LCI, MD-1 and D1-F) must be paid within sixty (60) days of the billing date.
2. File International PU-101 forms online by May 15 and send to the District 1-F Cabinet Secretary by May 15, 2018.
3. Update club monthly membership on LCI website each month, no later than the last day of the current reporting month.
4. Report club Service Activities in MyLCI nine of 12 months July-June 2017-18, using the Centennial Challenge link.
5. Attend at least one convention (District 1-F, MD-1, and/or International).
6. Attend club officer training:
 - A. District 1-F leadership training; or
 - B. Online training with Lions Club International's Leadership Development - Club Officer Orientation; or
 - C. Lions of Illinois, Inc. MD-1 Forum.
7. Club Secretary must complete three (3) of eight items:
 - A. Sponsor at least one member between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2018;
 - B. Send the club newsletter to the Webmaster and District Secretary in a timely manner for posting to the website;
 - C. Attend another club's meeting, not including your own multiple club meeting or quad, tri, etc.;
 - D. Attend another Lions club's event;
 - E. Attend one of the following:
 1. Lions of Illinois Foundation event;
 2. District 1-F Fall fun raiser;
 3. District 1-F Spring fun raiser;
 4. District 1-F Bowling Tournament; and/or
 5. Lions of Illinois MD-1 Forum.
 - F. Submit an article about the club to the District Newsletter (minimum 4 paragraphs - photos are a bonus!).
 - G. Present a seminar at Officer Training;
 - H. Serve at a District level as Committee Chair or Member.

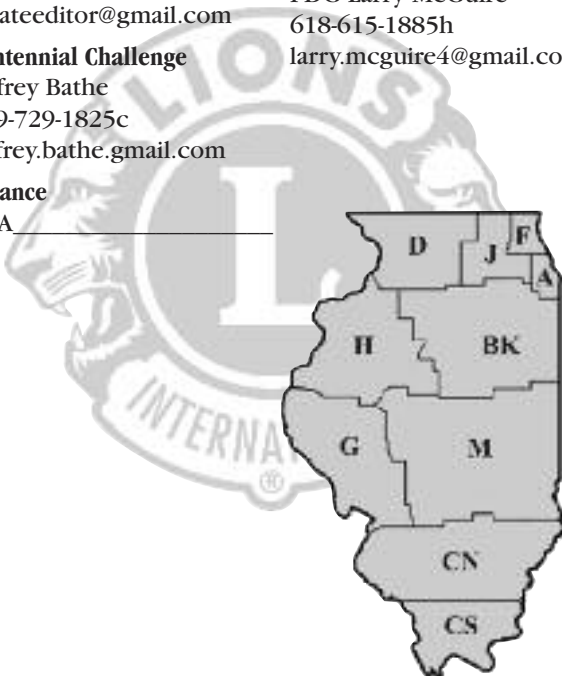

U.S. AND ILLINOIS GOVERNMENT FILING RULES FOR LIONS CLUBS

Government annual filings for Lions clubs are important to keep current. Late filing penalties can be severe. If a club's officers have questions, please ask your cabinet officers who to contact in our District to help you through these tough rules. Also, we can have training sessions to review these financial matters with you in more detail than can be presented here.

Lions Clubs International (LCI) and its member clubs have received a group federal tax exemption 0239, under Internal Revenue Code §501(c)(4). Each club is reported under this exemption by LCI.

Clubs must verify using the LCI website that the Federal Employer's Identification Number (FEIN) LCI uses for their club is the one that the club uses for its filings, and resolve any discrepancies.

All Lions clubs are required to file the annual online Federal Form 990-N or Form 990 or 990-EZ Information Return with the IRS.

Having previously registered as an Illinois charity, each club must also file an Annual Financial Report Form AG990-IL with the Office of the Illinois Attorney General:

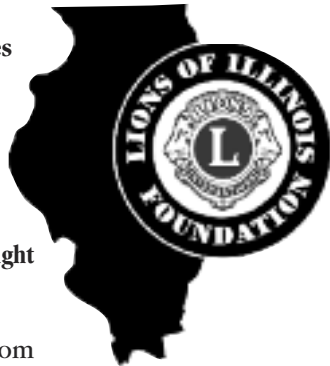


