At the same time, last year our total contributions were \$13,992.49, which is down by \$3,037.49. Hopefully, during the rest of Lions Centennial year, which ends in July 2018, we'll "up the ante", and contribute more in the future months.

As of July 2017, I will be a District 1F Lions of IL Foundation Trustee, as well as PDG Lion Walt Holden, and work with Lions Don Borgwardt and PDG Larry Spaeth to fundraise in our district.
