## **A Farewell to Lion Past Council Chairman Ron Foster**

*A partial excerpt from Lion PCC Baumer's eulogy:* Ron joined the Elk Grove Village Lions Club in June of 1968 and quickly exhibited his innate leadership abilities. He passed through the officer chairs and culminated in becoming Club President. In the process his abilities were noted by the District 1-F level and he soon was appointed as a Zone Chairman. He progressed successfully through the Zone levels and ultimately became the District 1-F Governor for 1982-1983. Even as a District Governor his outstanding leadership was noted as he was in turn elected as the Council Chairman of the District Governors. His value to Lionism was exhibited when he was awarded a Melvin Jones Fellowship in 1986 and later a Foundation Fellow Award. He was the driving force for the Elk Grove Village Lions and a mentor to us all.

*On a personal note from the Co-Editor:* Throughout everyone's life there are those people who project the ideals that you strive to live by. The ones that you hope you can live up to their expectations. During every Lion's activity at one point or another inevitably the question, "What does Ron think" would come up. We all tried to live up to his expectations and believe me, we would know immediately if we didn't. It wouldn't be because we were wrong – rather because he knew we could do better. He expected us to always do our best – nothing less. On the other hand, a word of praise from him was considered the highest reward one could receive. I personally cannot remember what was said when I received a Fellowship Award but, I can vividly remember those times when he quietly called me over and said I did well or those times when he would be listening to me talking and just quietly nod at me when I was done. Those times meant more to me than any awards I have ever received.
