(The entertainment value of watching Lion Walters (R) and Lion Dietz (D) bowl is well worth the price. Ed.)

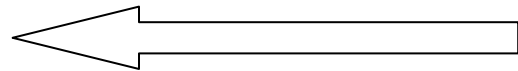

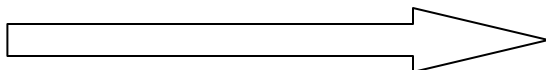

Lion President Brenner introduced Lion Walt Holden, Governor, District 1f; Dave Leganger, the accountant that completes the Club and Foundation tax reports; and Lion and Past District Governor (PDG) Paul Pioch.

Minutes: Lion Townsend moved, Lion Dietz (M) seconding, for approval of the November minutes. There was no vote.
