**Treasurer's report:** Lion Lee circulated a written report and made an oral report. On motion by Lion Lee, Lion Rockwell seconding, the report was placed on file subject to audit.

On motion by Lion Rockwell, Lion Jarvis seconding, the applications for membership by Debbie Jones and Sherry Perkowski were approved unanimously.

Lion Rockwell (for Lion Rich Walters) made a report on Tootsie Pop day. On motion by Lion Depke, Lion Schilling seconding, 60% of the money collect will be forwarded to the Lions of Illinois Foundation and 40% retained by the club.
