Note: You can only belong to one team.

Registration & Donation Form

Walkers, groups, and organizations need to register through their local Lions Club, Lioness Club, Leo Club, or direct with the Lions of Illinois Foundation. All registration forms, with donation money collected, should be turned in prior to the "Run/Walk for Sight" event. Each run/walker is encouraged to collect at least \$100 in donations.

All checks must be made payable to: *Lions* of Illinois Foundation. Donations are Tax Deductable.

Entry Fees

Adults: \$20 per individual run/walker.

High School Students and Younger:

Entry fee is free, but each run/walker is encouraged to collect at least \$50 in donations.
