#### **GET TO KNOW YOUR FACEBOOK PAGE**




OKnow Personal View vs Page View

#### **EDITING FACEBOOK PAGE DETAILS**

- 1. Click "Page Info." The info is fairly self-explanatory. Add as simple of a Web Address as you can. Facebook will let you know if the address is available to use.
- 2. Name: Name of your Club.
- 3. Username: Club name, no spaces
- Description: You can put your Club Officers and titles.
- Categories: Non-profit Organization and Charity Organization.
