


SHORTS

FOOD SECTION SPECIAL

Broccoli Slaw

- 1 (16 ounce) package broccoli coleslaw mix
- 2 (3 ounce) packages chicken flavored ramen noodles
- 1 bunch green onions, chopped
- 1 cup unsalted peanuts (I left peanuts out ~ would be interesting to try with)
- 1 cup sunflower seeds
- 1/2 cup white sugar
- 1/4 cup vegetable oil
- 1/3 cup apple cider vinegar
- Prep time: 15 minutes
- Ready time: 45 minutes

In a large salad bowl, combine the slaw, broken noodles and green onions.
 Whisk together the sugar, oil, vinegar and ramen chicken seasoning packets. Pour over salad and toss to evenly coat. Refrigerate until chilled; top with peanuts and sunflower seeds before serving. (I mixed the sunflower seeds into the salad)
