#### Adoption of New Constitution for District 1F

Lions Club International has issued a new Constitution and By-Laws, Standard District for Fiscal Year 2016-2017. The Standard form LA-4 has language that may not be changed, by any District, and via the Supremacy clause takes precedence over our current Constitution.

Our Constitution and By-Laws Committee for District 1F recommended that we incorporate the unique language from our old Constitution into the New Standard District LA-4 format and adopt this new Constitution at our District Convention in March.

The District 1F Cabinet agreed, and will submit a motion for consideration by the District 1F Delegates at the convention in March. The motion is for adoption of the New District 1F Constitution with the unique language from our old District Constitution that is permissible under the Supremacy clause.
